

ORDINANCE NO. 85- 7

WHEREAS, The City of Loogootee has an interest in providing for the unimpeded flow of pedestrian traffic for safety reasons over and along sidewalks in commercial areas; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for regulation of outside signs and displays of merchandise on sidewalks in commercial areas; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOOGOOTEE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That sidewalks shall remain unobstructed to pedestrian traffic for a distance of six (6) feet from the curb except as provided in Section 2.


SECTION 2. That a license or permit may obtained by businesses or other organizations for use of the six foot sidewalk area for events by making application to the Clerk-Treasurer. Such application shall describe the purpose of the event, the sponsors and participants thereof, and the duration of the event. Further the applicant shall show proof of liability insurance in the minimum amount of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00).


SECTION 3. Penalty for Violation: Any person violating the provisions of the foregoing ordinance shall be guilty of an infraction and, upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Five hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the foregoing ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and upon publication as required by the statutes.


